Milton adds another administrative position

District now has 16 administrative positions

MILTON — By a vote of 5-1 the Milton Area School District school board on Tuesday approved a Catawissa woman to fill the newly created assistant director of special education position.

Jennifer Oiler will be paid \$74,500 per year to fill the position, and will work 220 days per year.

Prior to casting the lone no vote against the position, board member Kevin Fry stressed that he was not opposed to the person selected to fill the position.

“I don’t know that the district can support this position financially,” Fry said.

He then asked Business Manager Brian Snyder how much the position would cost the district with health insurance and retirement benefits figured in.
